#### **OVERVIEW**

The National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF), ConocoPhillips and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service announced a new round of funding for ConocoPhillips SPIRIT of Conservation projects. More than \$1.1 million in grant funding will support conservation efforts to help conserve and recover populations of imperiled birds. The six awards announced leverage more than \$1.5 million in matching contributions from the grantees, providing a total conservation impact of \$2.6 million.

A longstanding partnership between NFWF, ConocoPhillips and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the ConocoPhillips SPIRIT of Conservation Program supports efforts to restore bird habitat, improve bird-focused conservation on working lands, and gather bird data that informs future conservation. With a focus on grassland, sagebrush, wetland and coastal habitats, the program helps advance voluntary solutions that improve the connectivity and quality of key breeding, stopover and overwintering habitats.
